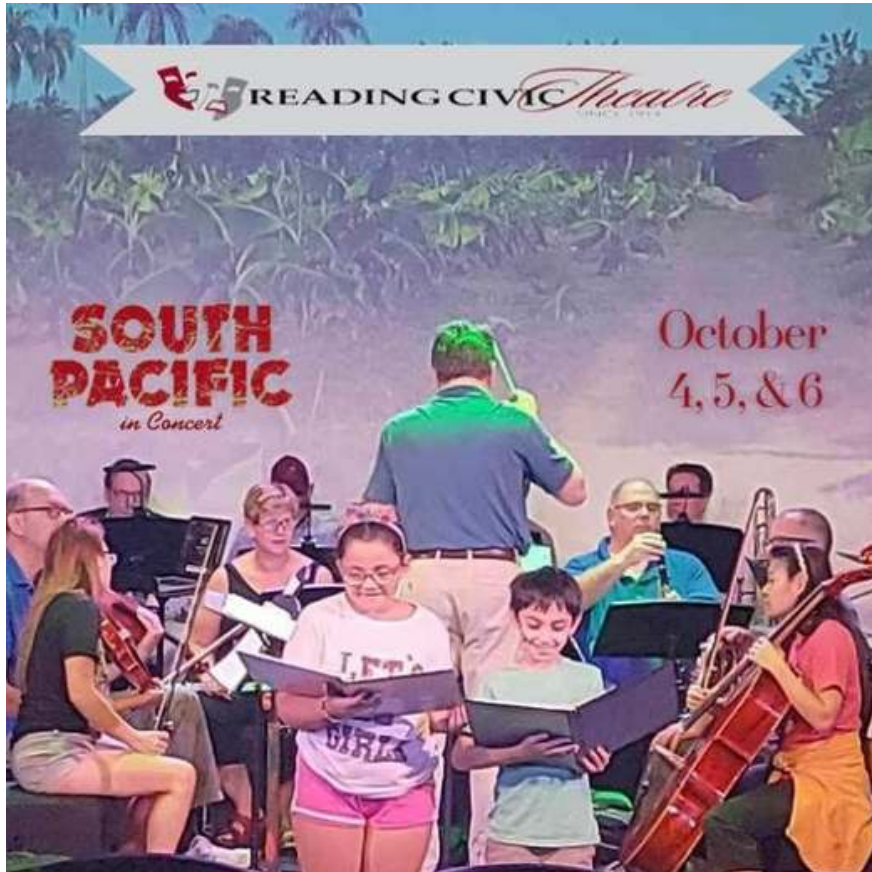

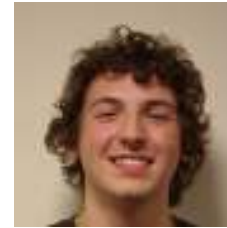

as Stewpot

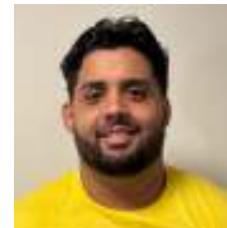

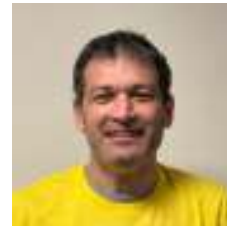

Jennifer Skinner

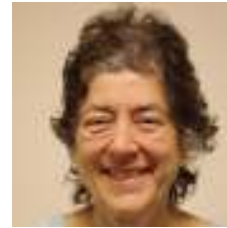
